Code of Ethical Standards For Church Leaders & Mandatory Reporting Responsibilities

All employees and those volunteers who work with children are required to read and sign off on the Code of Ethical Standards for Church Leaders as well as familiarize themselves with the procedures for reporting any physical or sexual abuse of a minor – Mandatory Reporting Procedures.

To access the Code of Ethical Standards for Church Leaders and the Mandatory Reporting Procedures online:

- Go to the Archdiocese of Milwaukee website (www.archmil.org)
- Once on the homepage, scroll down to Promise to Protect, Pledge to Heal
- Click on Safeguarding All of God's Family (formally VIRTUS)
- On the right hand side of the screen click on Resources.
- Scroll through to find both the Code of Ethical Standards for Church Leaders and the Mandatory Reporting Responsibilities (documents are available in English and Spanish).

The last page of the Code is the signature page. This must be printed, signed and returned to the Safe Environment Coordinator or your immediate supervisor at your parish and/or school. This must be on file prior to any employment or volunteer service.

If you do not have access to a computer, please request a copy of the Code of Ethical Standards for Church Leaders and the Mandatory Reporting Responsibilities from your parish and/or school.
