Scope and Content *a brief description of the types of materials in the collection.*

Papers of this pioneer/missionary priest and former St. Francis Seminary rector (1858-1874) contain: biographical information, including a biographical manuscript written by Max. Gaertner (1878); correspondence (1847-1876), which includes a letter to family describing the journey to the States (1847), and letters and German typescripts of correspondence to his friend Rev. Michael Wisbauer (1847-1858); a diary (1849-1854), including a German typescript; a folder of documents; newspaper clippings (1897); a parish announcement book from his days as pastor at St. Mary's, Milwaukee (1851-1854); a record book (1852-1855?); sermon outlines (1849-1873); a folder pertaining to Salzmänn's will and estate; and several other miscellaneous folders. The majority of the collection is in German.
