Scope and Contents

The collection consists primarily of newsletters (1959-1997). It also includes bylaws, membership lists, and awards banquet programs. The Catholic Social League formed in 1939. Its purpose was “to band together for clean and wholesome fun.” It was incorporated in Wisconsin on January 23, 1959.
