#### St. Boniface

- a. Happy the Archdiocese is promoting Diaconate Formation, but question remains as to **how to reach a potential aspirant, how to plant the seed?** Local Knights currently sponsor Vocation Nights. Happy to hear of the size of recent Deacon classes and that younger men are being formed.
- b. Remodeling and updating the parish, with education to parishioners, regarding why certain changes are being made, for example, moving the side altars. Also having presentations after 10:00 Mass, to increase members' understanding of the Eucharist, arranged by Fr. Mike.

## St. Gabriel

- a. Parish was very pleased with the Emmaus 90 program.
- b. Parish will be having the traveling Eucharistic Miracles exhibit June 15&16; school has Eucharistic Adoration; Deacon Schauer (sp?) from Green Bay presented on his book; small group studies on This Is My Body and Beautiful Eucharist; Gratitude and Intercessions after Mass.
