Jubilee Year 2025: Hope Does Not Disappoint

The Universal Church has entered the Jubilee Year 2025 (the 2,025th anniversary of the Incarnation of Our Lord). The great tradition of beginning the Jubilee Year with the opening the Holy Door took place when Pope Francis opened the Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica on December 24, 2024.

Archdiocesan Marian Shrine (N. 68th St.)
Schoenstatt Shrine (Waukesha)

These sites will become places at which anyone who enters will experience the love of God who consoles, pardons, and instills hope. Through visits to these holy sites people may discover a path to conversion, as an extraordinary moment of grace and spiritual renewal.
