## Access

Open/unrestricted except for prenuptial files, student transcripts, St. Vincent de Paul Society aid files, selected financial records, and personnel records. Restrictions are noted in the box and folder list.

## **Historical Note**

In 1896, only one year after Cudahy, WI was incorporated as a village and nearly 10 years before it would be incorporated as a city, St. Frederick's Church was founded to serve the town's growing German Catholic population. The church, named for Archbishop Frederick Katzer's patron saint, went through many iterations and locations to cope with its growth. First, in 1904 it was moved a few hundred feet from its original spot and rooms for classrooms were added. The church was moved again to its final location in 1908. In 1921 the cornerstone for a new church was laid in the same spot. Again in the 1950s the church underwent a rebuilding project, with the basement church dedicated in 1952, the upper church cornerstone laid in 1958, and the upper church completed and dedicated in 1959.

From 1905 to 1970 the church ran St. Frederick's School. The school closed due to declining enrollment in 1970, but at its height it boasted over 400 students. The school was run by religious sisters, and to accommodate them St. Frederick's owned a convent that was at first connected to the church building and then moved across the street before being sold in the 1980s.

The first pastor of St. Fred's was an Irish priest named George Durnin, who did not last long before being replaced by a German-speaking priest. The two longest-running pastors were Fr. John P. Herbst, who served 1907-1943, and Fr. George N. Orth, who served 1945-1968. In the wake of Vatican II, St. Fred's moved to a "team ministry" formation, with 1970 as the pastoral team's inaugural year. This team expanded into many different commissions all reporting to the pastoral council (founded in 1968). Lay ministry and the role of women were big focuses at St. Frederick's, with multiple women serving in important roles and completing Master's of Divinity degrees at nearby St. Francis Seminary. Social justice was also a large concern of the parish, and its Human Concerns Commission helped sponsor three Laotian refugee families to settle in Wisconsin and a Ugandan foreign exchange student to attend UW-Madison in the 1980s. It also supported workers in the 1987 Patrick Cudahy-Smithfield Foods boycott. The church also had several lively parish organizations, such as the Ladies Guild and a conference of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul.

Although St. Frederick's celebrated its 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary in 1996 with much ado, the parish merged with the other Cudahy parishes of St. Joseph and Holy Family to form the Nativity of Our Lord parish in 2000.

## Scope and Content a brief description of the types of materials in the collection.

This collection is divided into 5 series: Administrative, Financial, Historical, Parish Organizations, and Audio-Visual materials.

The Administrative series consists of meeting agendas and minutes, correspondence, reports, audits, and other committee records pertaining to the Pastoral Council and its various commissions. Of note are the bound volumes of the congregational minute books, which contain parish meeting minutes before the parish council existed; annual reports; original documents concerning the founding of the church; and the church's articles of incorporation and by-laws. Please note that some commission names changed over time or became defunct/replaced: The Human Concerns Commission was also known as the Social Justice Commission and the Social Awareness and Action Commission; the Fundraising Committee was once the Activities Commission; the Youth, Religious Education, and Parish Life Commissions eventually fell out of use. Additionally, the Administration Commission combined with the Finance Committee in 1997 and their combined records are kept in the Financial series. Finally, the refugee files contain some records written in the script and language of Lao.

The Financial series contains meeting minutes and agendas and correspondence of the Finance Committee and the combined Administrative and Finance Committee. It also contains finalized budgets, balance sheets and revenue and expense summaries, and some cash receipts and disbursements records for years where other financial records are scant. Also included are proxies and waivers for loans and property repairs and renovations, other property records such as sales, purchases, and repairs/renovations of property, and wills and bequests.

The Historical series contains bulletins (both loose and in bound volumes), newsletters, parishioner membership cards, news clippings, anniversary celebration materials, written parish histories, and objects and memorabilia. Of note is a parish history written in 1971 by parishioner and trustee Michael Joseph Heffron, who was a member of St. Frederick's from its founding until his death. It contains information about the circumstances of St. Fred's founding, the church's various priests and their activities, many of the church organizations and their membership, and it lists all the religious sisters involved with the parish over the years. Also of note is 1905 parish census listing parishioner ethnicities.

The Parish Organizations series includes administrative, financial, and historical records from different parish organizations, including the Society of St. Vincent de Paul, the Ladies Guild, the Holy Name Society, the Athletic Committee, and the Home and School Association. One unlabeled ledger appears to be from the Christian Mothers Sodality based on its years of existence and the members listed within.

The Audio-Visual series contains many photographs in various formats documenting parish life, including scrapbooks, slides, prints, film negatives, and photo plates. The photos show parish events, parishioners, priests, personnel, class photos, and shots of the church interior and exterior. The series also includes an audiocassette tape on the June 1997 installation, a two-part video on U-matic tape of a Team Ministry workshop held at Alverno College in 1978, an 8mm film of St. Fred's 1970-1971 programs, and an undated 15-minute long 16mm film titled "Parish programs."
